



## **Referral to Crown Counsel**

### **Disposition**

#### **IIO Investigation: 2017-028**

On October 17, 2018, Cpl. Jeff Easingwood of the RCMP was acquitted of the offence of driving without due care and attention, contrary to section 144(1)(a) of the *Motor Vehicle Act*.

On March 25, 2017, a male pedestrian suffered serious injuries in a motor vehicle incident in Prince Rupert involving a vehicle driven by an on-duty RCMP officer, Cpl. Easingwood. The IIO referred the matter to Crown Counsel with the BC Prosecution Service for consideration of charges on January 17, 2018.

The BC Prosecution Service initially charged Cpl. Easingwood on March 22, 2018.
