

## IIO DIRECTIVE 2025-01

From: The Chief Civilian Director (“CCD”) of the Independent Investigations Office of British Columbia (“IIO”)  
To: All police agencies in British Columbia and all officers over whom the IIO has jurisdiction, including all RCMP members in the province  
Date: January 23, 2025  
Subject: Recordings produced by body-worn cameras

---

Effective immediately, pursuant to Part 7.1 of the *Police Act* and the duty it imposes on all officers to cooperate fully with IIO investigations, the CCD directs that:

- in every investigation under IIO jurisdiction where any body-worn camera recording with potential relevance to the investigation may exist, any officer aware of the existence of the recording shall take all necessary steps to preserve the recording and to notify an IIO investigator of its existence; and
- in every such investigation, any recording produced by a body-worn camera worn by any officer, regardless of the officer’s actual or potential IIO designation, if deemed by an IIO investigator to have potential evidentiary value, shall be provided to the investigator upon request.
